218 Benefit Assessment for Fire Protection & Emergency Response Services

In July of 2023, Madison Fire proposed an assessment to provide additional funding to the Madison Fire Protection District. Since then, Madison Fire has received strong support from the community to vote on the measure again.

Funding from this measure would allow Madison Fire to:

- Ensure Rapid Response Times to 9-1-1 Emergencies
- Update unsafe Firefighting Equipment
- Replace aging fire apparatus
- Assist with Volunteer recruitment, retention & training
- Hire additional firefighters
- Protect Property from Threat of Wildfires
- Improve Station daily staffing

Improved Daily Station Staffing Schedule:

2 firefighters staffing the station 24 hours a day. The assessment would allow Madison Fire to add additional paid staffing that would increase the daily staffing to 1 paid firefighter on duty for 24 hours a day and will support one to two Volunteers also staffing the station 24 hours a day with volunteers responding to the station 24 hours a day for calls for service

100% of the Funding will stay with the Madison Fire District -the county & the state cannot take it away
